As part of the execution activities of the investment program "Improvement of justice services in non-criminal matters through the implementation of the Electronic Judicial File" (EJE), the process of equipping and transferring modern state-of-the-art equipment began. technology, which were acquired by the PMSAJ- EJENOPENAL, in favor of the Constitutional Court, through the project "Improvement of the service provision model of the Constitutional Court to achieve the proper implementation of the EJE". This was possible by virtue of the Inter-Institutional Cooperation Agreement signed between the heads of the Ministry of Justice and Human Rights and the Constitutional Court, previously carried out within the framework of this important Contract of loan. will be addressed to contribute to the achievement of the Program objectives.

The delivery of goods acquired by the PM-SAJ- EJENOPENAL to be transferred to the Constitutional Court, the beneficiary entity of the Program. It consisted of 5 Image Capturers (production scanner); 200 perpetual licenses of Nitro-Pro Software and a Dell Application Blade Server. The cession of these equipments occurred progressively since July, pending only the delivery of two switches for a 24-port network with 56 GBps, whose delivery is scheduled for the first fortnight of August.

The reception of the computer equipment by the Constitutional Court was in charge of the Head of the Information Technology Office of said institution, Ing ° César Rodríguez Alegre. The delivery procedure was carried out at the facilities of the Central Warehouse of the TC, after verification and control of each of the instruments, in order to verify their good working order.

In this first delivery of the technological equipment, the PMSAJ-EJENOPENAL was attended by Gloria Landeo Alva, specialist in Acquisitions and Christian Santisteban Torres, Heritage Analyst, while César Rodríguez Alegre, Chief of the Information Technology Office and Manuel Calixto Núñez, in charge of the Logistics warehouse, who formalized the receipt of these goods with the signing of the corresponding Delivery-Reception minute.

As is known, this first delivery of equipment is framed within the activities programmed in the component "Adequate ICT support infrastructure for the adoption of the EJE", which aims to provide support to the Constitutional Court for the improvement of its processes and information systems and at the same time improve its management model to increase efficiency and transparency in the provision of its services, which will allow the supreme interpreter of the Constitution to provide a more efficient constitutional justice administration service for its users, as that with these modern high-tech computer equipment they will be allowed to have better work tools and provide greater comfort to the servers, so that they can provide a quality service to the citizen.

In that sense, several remaining teams will be implemented soon, the same ones that will be added to this installment. All this will redound to the benefit of the community, and will considerably reduce the time and cost of processing judicial processes in constitutional matters, perceiving greater speed and efficiency in meeting their needs.

This constitutes one more effort, of the PMSAJ, within the framework of the execution of the EJE NO PENAL program, in order to modernize the Justice Administration System, with the aim of providing a greater and better justice service to the citizens.
