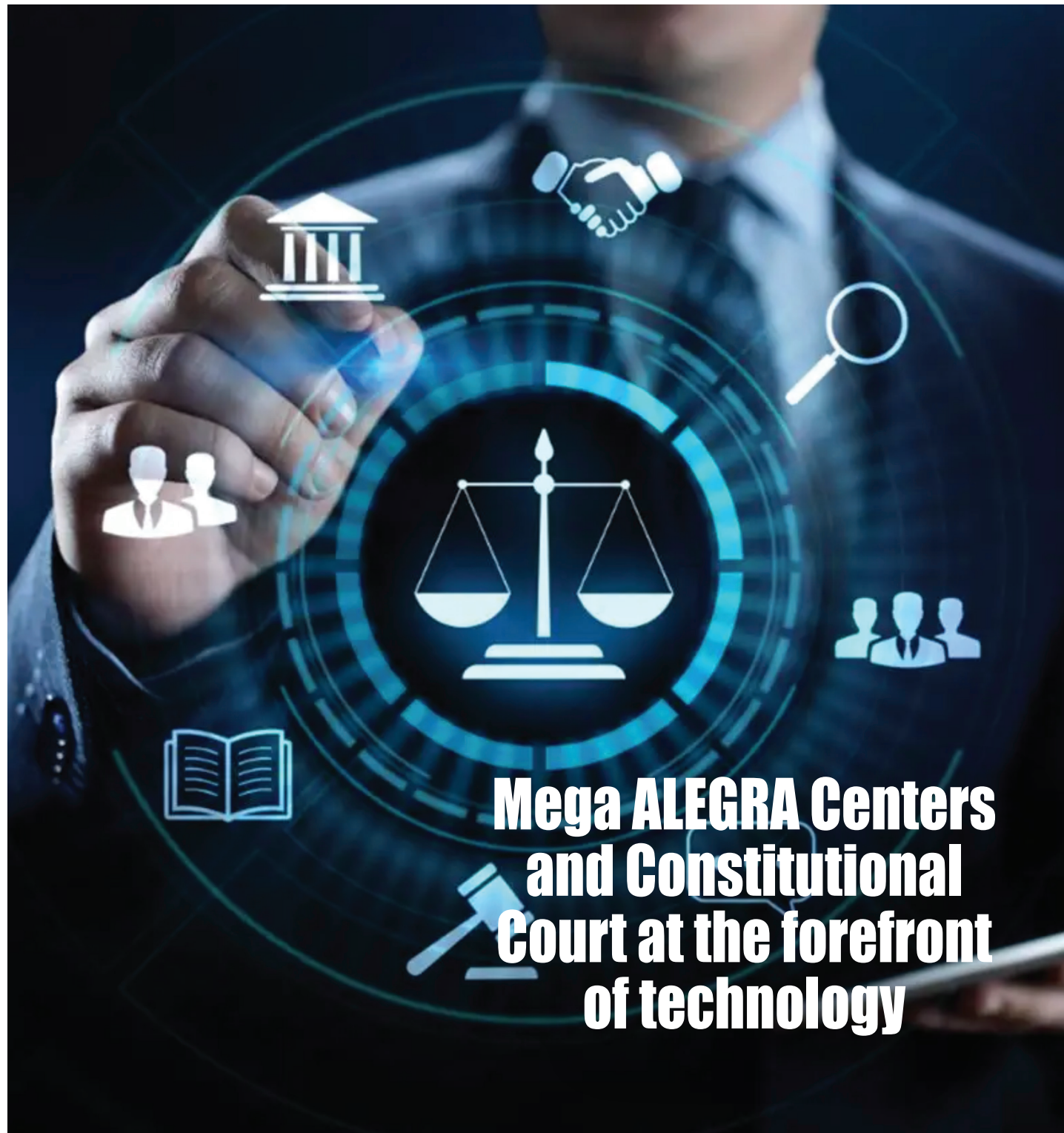


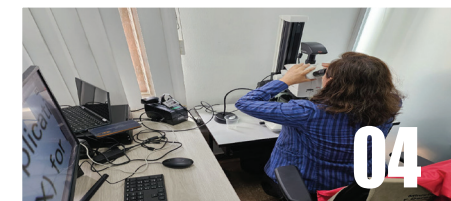

State-of-the-art stereoscopic microscopes were delivered to the forensic experts of the Multidisciplinary Services Directorate of the General Directorate of Public Defense and Access to Justice.

In compliance with the objectives set out in component number three, entitled “Reduction of socio-economic, cultural and geographical barriers for vulnerable populations to access justice”, the Improvement Program of the Justice Administration Services - Eje No Penal, delivered nine (09) stereoscopic microscopes for the forensic experts who make up the multidisciplinary team and

carry out their functions in the Mega ALEGRA centers at the national level.

Strengthening services at Mega ALEGRA centers

These advanced stereo microscopes are intended to enhance the services of Mega ALEGRA centers nationwide. With the implementation of this technology, the forensic experts of

the multidisciplinary team will be able to carry out more detailed and accurate investigations in cases of sexual abuse, homicide and other crimes. Since they allow observation in three dimensions, which facilitates the identification of crucial details in forensic samples, strengthening

the quality of investigations and the presentation of evidence in trials. In this way, the specialized experts of the Mega ALEGRA centers, in Lima Centro, Villa El Salvador, Callao, Abancay, Arequipa, Ayacucho, Trujillo and Chanchamayo, will be able to benefit from this important tool to provide

free and comprehensive legal defense to the vulnerable population.

Investment and Financing

The Eje No Penal Program has allocated more than s/ 2,978,640.00 for the acquisition of this equipment.

This investment includes the purchase of the microscopes, delivery, installation, training, technical support, guarantee and maintenance. This achievement was possible thanks to the loan agreement signed between the World Bank and the Peruvian State to strengthen non-criminal justice services through the implementation of the Electronic Judicial File.

The work of experts for the benefit of the population

Public defense experts play a crucial role in the legal system by providing specialized services to people who cannot afford legal ad-

vice. His work includes reviewing forensic evidence, interpreting evidence, and providing expert reports, contributing to the development of strong arguments in court cases. With the incorporation of these stereo microscopes, experts have a state-of-the-art tool that improves the quality of their analyses, directly benefiting the population by strengthening free legal defense.

Ongoing commitment

In this way, the Eje No Penal Program reaffirms its commitment to improving the services of the ALEGRA and Mega ALEGRA centers

of public defense, for the protection of the rights of vulnerable populations, promoting the implementation of state-of-art technologies that seek to strengthen access to justice in the country.

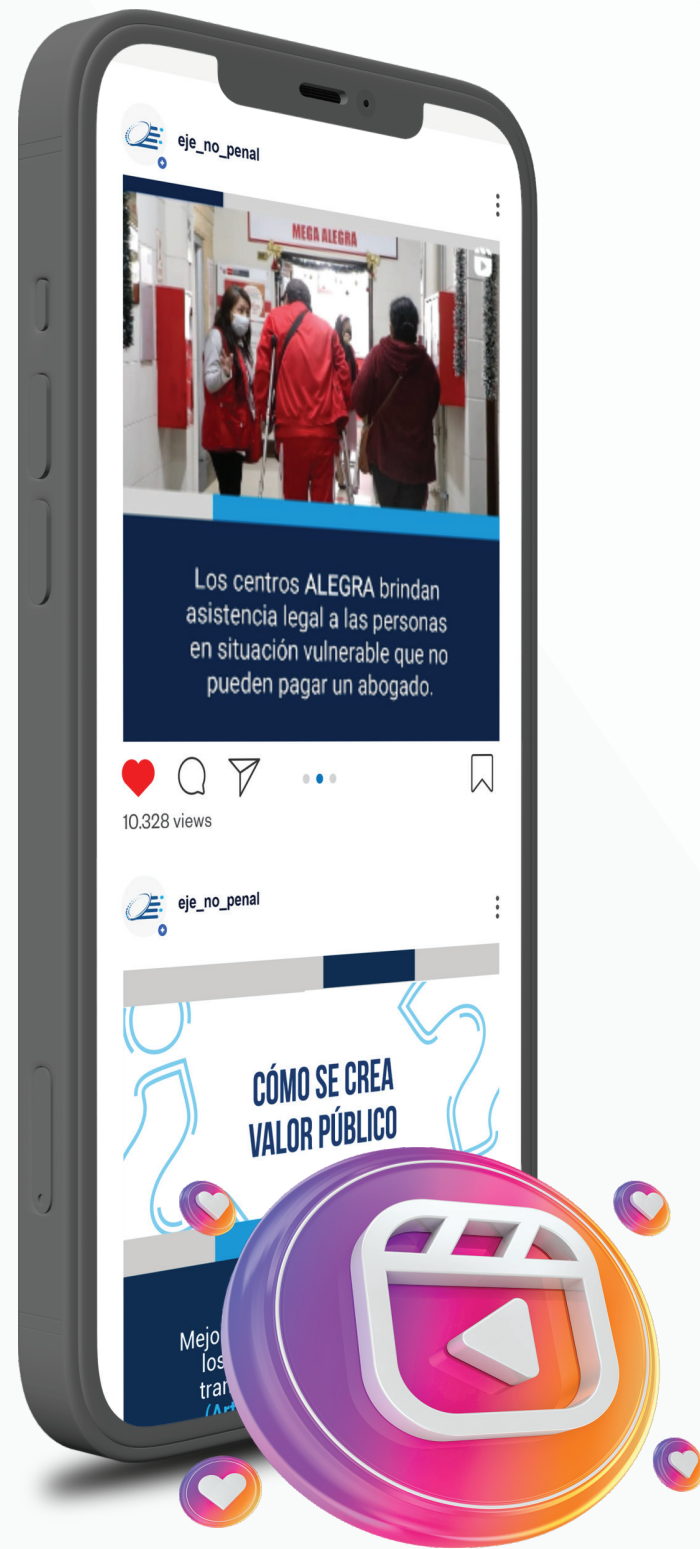
